# Message from the Pastor



## **Alive with Christ**

Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him." (Romans 6:8,9)

Easter Sunday has come and gone. The baskets have been put away, and the candy (mostly) eaten. Stores have taken down the Easter displays to concentrate on the next holidays coming up: Mother's Day, Memorial Day, and the Fourth of July.

But at church we will continue the Easter celebration. The altar cloths will remain white for Easter, symbolizing Christ's holiness and exaltation. The Easter banners will remain at church. Each Sunday in May will continue the theme: "Christ Is Risen!"

Even after the Easter season will be done (June 1st this year), we Christians will still reflect on Christ's resurrection. Paul did the same when he wrote to Christians in Rome. Because Christ has been raised, he has conquered death. "Death no longer has mastery over him." So if we belong to Christ, if we have "died with him" and our sins were crucified with him on the cross, then we shall also live with him.

We are alive with Christ! That means we will no longer let Satan and sin steer us in the ways that displease the Lord. That means that, even though we still stumble into sin, we won't let sin be our master. Alive with Christ, we will let the Spirit steer us toward a life that is pleasing to our Lord God.

Alive with Christ! So don't pack away the thoughts of Christ's resurrection from your hearts. Reflect on Jesus' victory, and also look forward to his triumphant coming on the Last Day of the world. We who are dead will rise again, and we who are living when he comes will not even taste death, but will live with Christ forever! Let us always cling to this lifegiving truth all our lives, and live for Christ who is the one who gives us the victory over sin and death.
